Details of Wimborne Camera Clubs digital equipment for Visiting presenters

Wimborne has a complete digital presentation system available if required.

This consists of:

Digital Projector	Canon XEED SX60. This has a maximum resolution of 1400 pixel wide by 1050 pixel high. It has both VGA and DVI connections.
Computer	This is a high performance "Cube" system with 2Gb memory and a separate screen with 1400 by 1050 resolution. It can run the screen and projector either in "clone" mode (both screen and projector showing the same image), or with screen and projector in extended desktop mode.
Audio	A good quality stereo audio system driven from the computer sound system
Software	The computer has Adobe Photoshop CS3, Adobe Photoshop Elements 5, Photodex Proshow Gold, and Faststone Image viewer installed.
Calibration	A calibration system for the projector is available, but calibration of a computer with the projector takes a short while and needs to be done in the room with the light out. If calibration is required, the presenter must make special arrangements and arrive sufficiently early for this to be done before the majority of the audience arrive.

It is recommended than, in most cases, presenters should bring their own computer (so that they are familiar with it, and know it has the correct software and images etc.) and make use of the club's projector.

(If the presenter has a projector we suggest that they bring it with them if possible.

Mistakes, accidents and failures do happen and it's better safe than sorry. If the presenter does not have a projector, or can't bring one, please let the club contact know and we will arrange for a club member to bring a spare "just in case")
